MAJOR SPILL REPORT TO EPD

DATE OF MAJOR SPILL: Friday, September 27, 2024, 12:03 pm – 3:44 pm

REPORT SUBMITTED: Monday, September 30, 2024

LOCATION OF MAJOR SPILL: <u>150 Willie Smokie Glover Drive</u> - MH ID: 57743 (Please note that the address used is a reference for the location of the manhole.)

CAUSE OF MAJOR SPILL: The causes of this major spill were hydraulic overload due to heavy rains in the MWA service area and a power failure at The Lower Poplar Water Reclamation Facility. As a result, sewer mains that feed the plant surcharged and caused this manhole to overflow. According to the National Weather Service, from September 25th to September 27th, Macon-Bibb received approximately 7.55 inches of rain.

ESTIMATED VOLUME DISCHARGED: 45,725 gallons

(Please note that this quantity is only a calculated **estimation** of the volume of sewage that spilled from our system. More sewage may have escaped the system.)

RECEIVING WATERS: Ocmulgee River

SERVICE BASIN AFFECTED: Bay Street

WRF SERVICE AREA NPDES PERMIT: GA0024538

CORRECTIVE ACTION TAKEN TO MITIGATE OR TO REDUCE ADVERSE EFFECTS: Debris has been removed from the area. The affected area has also been sprayed with

Debris has been removed from the area. The affected area has also been sprayed an enzyme treatment for organic waste called Bio-Bug.

SPILL STATUS: Sewage is no longer escaping.

SIGNS POSTED: Friday, September 27, 2024

CORRECTIVE ACTION TAKEN TO PREVENT FUTURE SPILL: The power failure issue was resolved, and service was restored to the plant.
