Debris has been removed from the area. The affected area has also been sprayed with an enzyme treatment for organic waste called Bio-Bug.

CORRECTIVE ACTION TAKEN TO PREVENT FUTURE SPILL: MWA has contacted a contractor to investigate approximately 2,500 linear feet which will use CCTV/Sonar to analyze any sediment and corrosion in the sewer line.
