CAUSE OF MINOR SPILL: The cause of this minor spill was a result of concrete and debris entering a manhole that was damaged by a contractor.

ESTIMATED VOLUME DISCHARGED: 8,800 gallons
*(Please note that this quantity is only a calculated **estimation** of the volume of sewage that spilled from our system. More sewage may have escaped the system.)*

RECEIVING WATERS: Ocmulgee River

SERVICE BASIN AFFECTED: Main Street

WRF SERVICE AREA NPDES PERMIT: GA0024538

CORRECTIVE ACTION TAKEN TO MITIGATE OR TO REDUCE ADVERSE EFFECTS: Debris has been removed from the area. The affected area has also been sprayed with an enzyme treatment for organic waste called Bio-Bug.

SPILL STATUS: Sewage is no longer escaping.

SIGNS POSTED: Wednesday, March 20, 2024

CORRECTIVE ACTION TAKEN TO PREVENT FUTURE SPILL: This line is scheduled to be cleaned and televised. The manhole will be repaired by the contractor.
